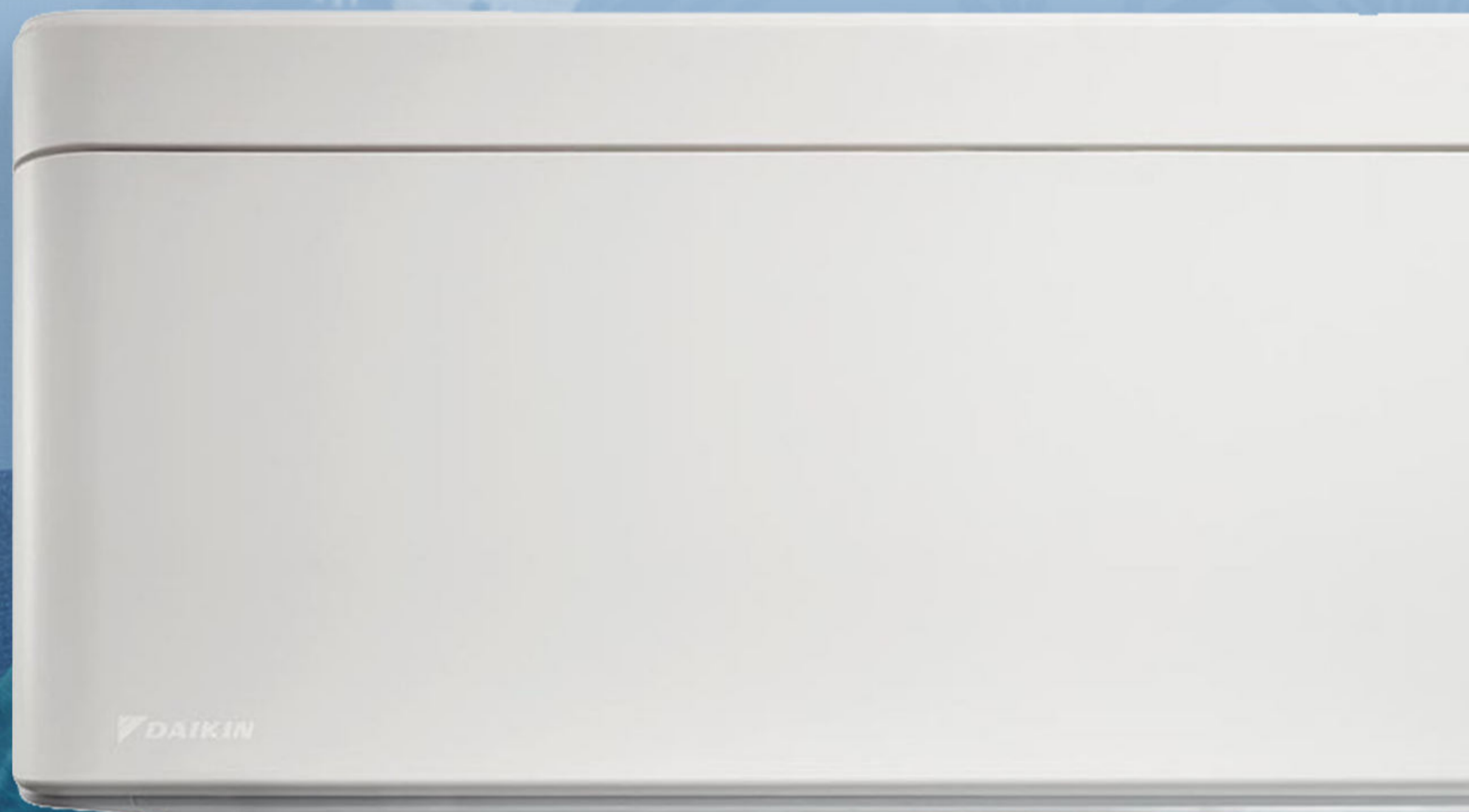


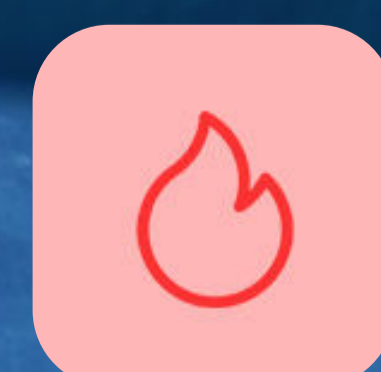

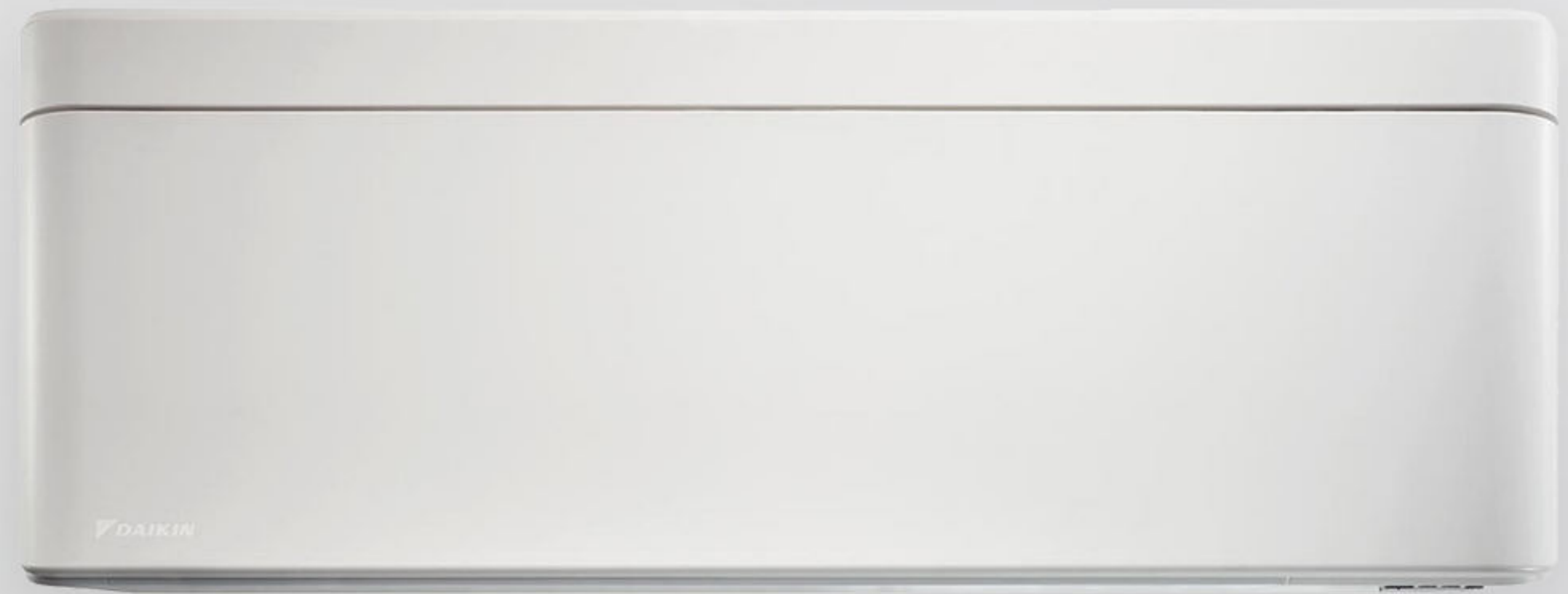

8 Things We Bet You Didn't Know About Air Conditioning



1. Air Conditioning Can Be Used As Heating

Air conditioning not only cools; it heats too. Most people don't realise that air-conditioning units make effective heaters. Our units are air-to-air heat pumps that use a vapour-compression refrigeration cycle to produce either cool or warm the air. In-built fans then circulate the air around the room.

2. Energy-Efficient Heating

Air-to-air heat pumps come with A+++ energy ratings. They waste very little energy and are highly efficient heaters. In fact, they have a SCOP (Seasonal Coefficient of Performance) rating of 3.0 – 4.0. that means that for every 1kw of electricity used, you get 3 to 4kw of heat: <https://energyguide.org.uk/air-to-air-heat-pumps/>





3. Renewable Energy Heat Source

Air-to-air heat pumps produce heat using the thermal qualities found naturally in air. To operate, 80% of the heat produced relies on renewable energy and only 20% on mains electricity. Air-to-air heat pumps don't release harmful components into the atmosphere either. Therefore, using air conditioning to warm a room is sustainable and eco-friendly.

4. Air Conditioning Reduces Allergens

Allergy sufferers can breathe a sigh of relief. Air conditioning cleans and filters the air, improving the quality for everyone. Pollen, dust, humidity, mould and chemicals can irritate the nose, throat, lungs and eyes. Asthma can be exacerbated when the air isn't healthy. An efficient ventilation system eases all of these symptoms. Air conditioning really comes into its own here – the air in your home is continuously improved as it circulates through the system.



5. Domestic Air Con Is Quiet

Commercial air con units are often a bit noisy, but thankfully domestic models are the total opposite. Both the indoor and outdoor units are quiet and won't interrupt your sleep. Amazingly, our indoor units operate at around 19dB – for comparison, a normal fridge-freezer produces 32dB.

6. No VAT To Pay

As part of the 2022 Spring Budget, the Chancellor removed VAT on energy saving heating devices installed in homes. Our air con units are now 0% VAT because they are air-to-air heat pumps. There has never been a better time to consider installing air conditioning!



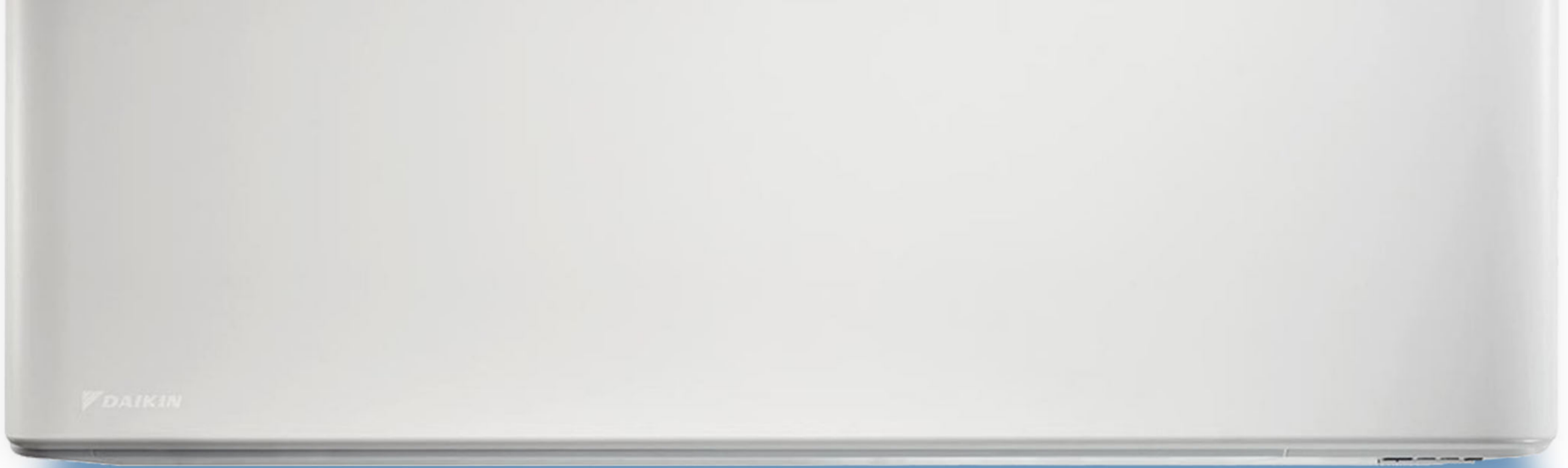
7. Modern Air Con Units Ooze Style

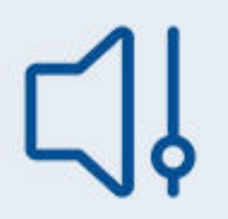
Breathe Deeper
